During this unprecedented time, we are pleased to offer South Amboy residents walk-in services!

We've been taking the precautions of quarantining and sanitizing returned materials, keeping a safe distance from each other, wearing face masks, checking everyone's temperature, using hand sanitizer, and disinfecting work surfaces and public keyboards, as recommended by the CDC and other professional organizations. The Book Drop is being used for returned materials. Plexiglas shields are installed at the public service desks. Computers are available for one-hour sessions. Patrons who cannot wear a face covering or come into the building can still take advantage of our contact-free curbside service.

Due to services being staff-assisted right now, library hours are Monday through Friday 12-5pm and Thursday 12-5pm and 6-8 pm. Services include assistance borrowing materials, faxing, wireless printing, photocopying, as well as having the latest bestsellers and media.
